

To NP team copied to Tony Merry

Please find attached copies of my response to the Charlbury Neighbourhood Plan as discussed with Tony recently. I note that although Peter Kendrick did agree to come and see me to discuss the proposal, to date he has not done so.

This is my second objection, and I would like a response as to why the team did not respond to my initial objection, no effort was made to discuss this proposal with me at any time. I understand that consultation with stakeholders is an underlying principle in creation of neighbourhood plans, and that includes land/garden owners as well as residents. I have to point out that the inclusion of the garden of Blenheim Farm House when no other private gardens have been included does feel very personal and indeed part of the campaign which has been waged against me as the owner of Blenheim Farm House both online on the Charlbury Forum and in person in my property.

I would argue most strongly that the inclusion of my property/garden does not meet the National Planning Policy criteria for designation as green space.

I look forward to receiving your response, and after speaking with the Community Planning Officer at WODC I understand that all correspondence including this email must be forwarded with the plan. For the record I also include my original letter of objection and that should also be included.
